

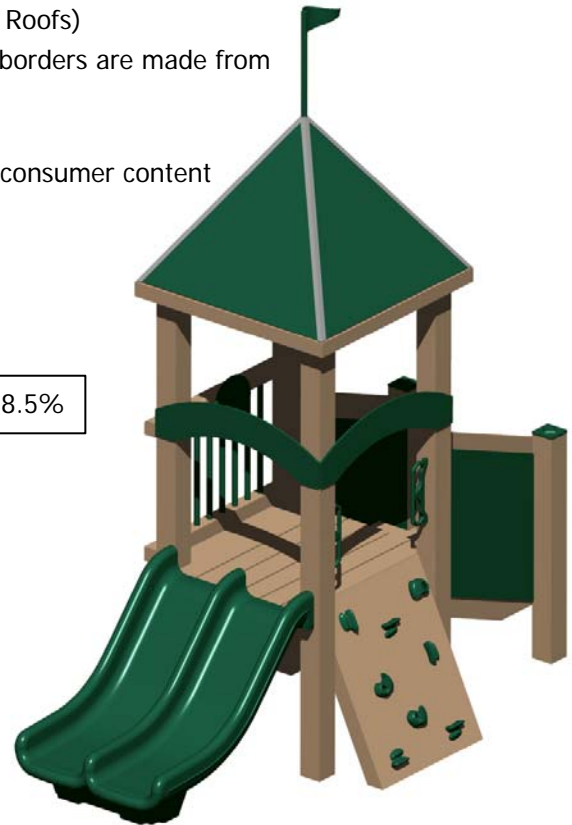
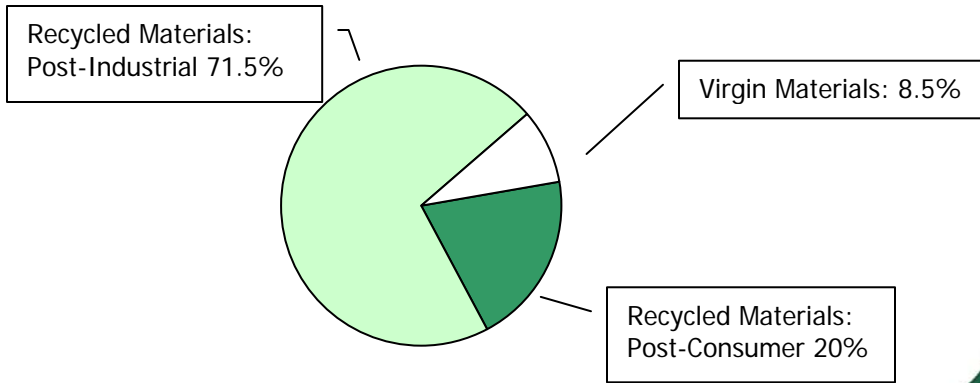


# NAHB Standard 504.1: *RECYCLED MATERIALS*

## How Play Mart can contribute:

*The average play system offers a 60-80% post-industrial recycled content and 10-25% post-consumer content by weight.*

- All decking (start date TBA) 100% post-consumer HDPE
- All flat-plastics 100% post-consumer plastics (e.g. color panels, Castle Roofs)
- RSP™ (for all structural materials such as posts), tables, benches and borders are made from 100% post-industrial HDPE plastics
- All steel tubing 85% recycled content
- All rubber surfacing options (rubber, tile, poured-in-place) 100% post-consumer content
- Rubber borders 100% post-consumer



## NAHB (National Assoc. of Home Builders) Standard 504.1

Post-consumer or post-industrial recycled-content building materials are used. (Max. of 6 points allowed)

A. List of materials used including recycled content amount.

(1) 2 types of materials are used: 3 Points

(2) Per additional material used: 1 Point

List of materials used including recycled content amount.

## Strategy:

For higher recycled content choose components with high recycled content values such as:

- RSP™ (Decks, posts, Arch Bridge, Arch Climber)
- Flat Plastics (Color panels, Village Roofs)

Choose Rubber or RSP™ borders and rubber surfacing options to significantly increase your recycled content percentages.

Call for a recycled content estimate on a specific system, or to ask for help optimizing systems for recycled content.
